

Notes:

- 1 Shield should not be exposed anywhere along wire trajectory.
- 2 Backshell **must** clamp around the **outer sheath** of the cable. Cut outer sheath accordingly.
- 3 Computer-side backshell must contain a 120 Ohm 1/4 watt axial lead resistor between conductors 2 and 7
- DO NOT connect the computer-side cable shield to anything, and make sure it does not touch the resistor in that backshell
